The abstract should be written in English and within 200-250 words, including the principal objectives and the scope of the investigation, the methodology used, summarized results and principal conclusions.

The text of the abstract should be in Times New Roman, Normal, 11 pt, justified, single line spacing (ISC_template.doc).

Submission deadline is 1 June 2017.

Submitted abstracts accepted by the Scientific Committee of ISC2017 will be published in Book of Abstracts.

Notification of acceptance by the Scientific Committee will be emailed to the corresponding author and he/she will be invited to prepare oral or poster presentation to be presented at the conference.

Submission of abstract, presentation and participation at ISC2017 is FREE of charge.
